



AIRSOFT COMBAT GAMING ZONE ACHONRY CO. SLIGO

Administration

- All rules apply to everyone without exception whether they are members or visitors.
- Site refers to all gaming areas and all property owned or leased by the Company/Club.
- The entire Site has a wire fence running the entire length of its boundaries just outside the tree lines and in some places has added green mesh erected. All gaming is to take place within the Site boundary and under no circumstances are players to leave the Site area.
- Viper Airsoft operate a Zero Tolerance rule against abuse of any kind against its staff, Marshals and other players. No alcohol or illegal substances are allowed on Site. Anyone engaging in these activities or who is deemed to be impaired will be asked to leave the Site and the Gardaí may be called.
- **The management reserves the right to refuse admission and or exclude any individual or group it deems necessary from the site without explanation or where they deem circumstances may require it for safety reasons.**

Important

1. All members and visitors must sign in at the Main Safe Zone area, opposite the carpark area before entering any part of the Site.
2. All vehicles are parked at owner's risk and management will not be held responsible for any theft or any type of damage of any kind caused to any vehicles while on the property. It is important to note that people are responsible for their own personal belongings while on site. Precautionary measures are taken by the club in an effort to minimise loss or damage, however, management will not accept any responsibility for any damage or loss of personal belongings while on site.
3. All players and visitors must sign an insurance waiver before they start gaming and must understand all gaming rules. Any players under the age of **18** must have a parent or guardian present to fill out the Under-18's Indemnity Form in order to give consent to play. At present no one under the age of 12 may play at the Site unless permission is granted prior to attending. Proof of ID is required.
4. Any visitors who wish to go out onto the gaming areas must be escorted at all times by a member of staff. Non-players must fill out the Insurance Waiver Form prior to entering any of the gaming areas.
5. A mobile phone is available on site to call emergency services in the event of an accident. One of the Marshal's will carry a first aid kit when out in the gaming area. There will also be a first aid kit held at the Main Safe Zone at all times.
6. Eye protection is mandatory by law in the form of goggles or approved glasses and must be worn at all times within the gaming areas. It is a legal requirement that full face protection be worn by anyone under the age of **18**. Those only wearing goggles (mesh or plastic) or glasses (mesh or plastic) do so at their own risk. Viper Airsoft will not accept responsibility for injuries to the face where only goggles or glasses (mesh or plastic) are worn.
7. No sharp hazardous objects or knives of any description barring small "multi-tools" are allowed on Site. Multi-tools & other AEG tools must be kept at the Main Safe Zone.
8. All safety regulations set out within these rules or covered by the Safety Brief, will be strictly adhered to by all parties whilst on Site. Failure to do so may result in exclusion from the Site without a refund for the offending parties.
